<b>ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH</b>	Joseph P. Blais was employed as a pipefitter for MacMillan Bloedel Limited in Powell River for 35 years. J.P Blais resided at 658 East Rd Cranberry Lake in 1955 and 660 East Cranberry Lake in 1958. In August 1969 he received his Certificate of Apprenticeship and Certificate of Qualification for Steamfitting and Pipefitting from the Department of Labour.
<b>CUSTODIAL HISTORY</b>	The records were donated to the museum by the creator's son David Blais.
<b>FONDS DESCRIPTION</b>	The fonds consists of several files of material including a photograph, certificates and promotional material from Macmillan Bloedel which belonged to Joseph P. Blais.
