ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH	Victor Alfred Brister (1887-1967) was born in England. He married Margaret McLeod in 1915. It is not clear where he worked prior to coming to Powell River in 1928 to act as a BC government fire warden, a position he kept until his move to Thurston Bay on Sonora Island in 1930. He worked for BC Hydro as an engineer for 40 years.
