She had one sister, June. Her stepfather was Art Reed, who owned and operated a taxi company. Audree married Jim Carrie and they raised their children in Powell River. During WW II Audree worked in the Powell River Company mill as a pulp tester. She was a member of a variety of local organizations until her death in Powell River in 2004.
