ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH	<p>In 1942 Cranberry lake was incorporated as a Village with the first government-assigned commissioners, Ray Weaver, chairman, Norman MacIntosh and Al Alsgard, the latter being replaced due to a technicality by Jimmy Ford.</p> <p>Former governance and management of the community had been established back in 1929 by the organization of a community club named the Cranberry Progressive Association. The name was later changed in the spring of 1930 to the Cranberry Lake Ratepayers and Community Association. In September 1930 the community further elected trustees to the newly formed Cranberry Light and Waterworks District (or Cranberry Waterworks District).</p> <p>The Village provided road maintenance, road improvements, housing permits, garbage collection and collected taxes. The Corporation of the Village of Cranberry Lake amalgamated with Westview, Wildwood, and Townsite in 1955</p>
