He was raised in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan and moved to Powell River in 1927. He worked in the Powell River Company pulp and paper mill and retired in 1975. He and his wife Verna had three children. Verna died in 1974 and he married Gertrude in 1988. Dunn was an enthusiastic amateur photographer and took many photographs of his family, Powell River and his travels. |
