ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH	Clarence (1900-1982) and Mary Margaret (1904-1993) lived at 701 Cranberry Street (in 1959 the address was changed to 7032 Cranberry Street). In 1956, portions of District Lot 4128 and District 5200 were sold to Charles Mervin Entner. In 1962, Angelo and Nellie Giordiano signed a Subdivision of District Lots 4128 and 5200. In 1976 the Corporation of the District of Powell River processed an Indenture of \$50 in order that a sewer line could be developed. In 2002 the dwelling at 7018 Cranberry Street was assessed by a real estate company.
