He was ordained as a minister in the United Church of Canada in 1938 and in the same year he married Megan Griffiths (1912-). Reverend Golightly travelled to Texada Island and Powell River in 1938 to preach the gospel to the communities of Blubber Bay, Van Anda and Cranberry.
