HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH	Gleb Goumeniouk (1915–1965) was born in Russia and moved to Canada when a teenager. He earned a degree in Engineering from the University of British Columbia. He was Powell River Company's Research Director from 1948-1951(?). He developed a new method of feeding pulp to newsprint machines and he designed a head box for Paper Machine #8. He and his family moved to Vancouver, where he worked as a consultant until his death.
CUSTODIAL HISTORY	Donated by Violet Goumeniouk (née Davies). Upon arrival the material was in two binders with loose papers. The fonds was arranged in the early 1990s and reappraisal was done in June 2007. An artificial arrangement was imposed by the archivist.
