<b>ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH</b>	<p>The 1967 Powell River Centennial Committee was part of a nation-wide celebration of 100 years of Confederation. As well as hosting Canada's Centennial Caravan and the Centennial Stage Coach tour, the Committee's main project was the development of the Centennial building on Marine Avenue opposite Willingdon Beach. The tennis courts at Willingdon Beach were also part of this project. The Centennial Committee also supported various community activities including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sponsoring Miss Centennial;</li> <li>• aid to the Music Festival;</li> <li>• supporting the Juvenile Soccer Association;</li> <li>• hosting a pioneer reception;</li> <li>• sponsoring the July 1st Centennial Parade; and</li> <li>• other projects.</li> </ul>
